GRANT.

KALAKAUA, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

Mrs. Tepoka Kimo

for the consideration of Two Hundred (200) Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at Kulakaha Honolulu in the Island of Oahu and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on North side of Young Street
and to South West from North angle of Young and
Kauaunui Streets, thence running by true bearings;
S 91° 12' E 146 40
S 68 64 W 50
S 21 12 N 146 70
S 68 48 E 50
point on Young Street to the Initial
and being a portion of Lot 222 Kulakaha being
Lot O of Auction Sale of July 11, 1889.
