## GRANT

**KALAKAUA**, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

Mrs Grace Pidd nee Booth

for the consideration of Five Hundred (500) Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at

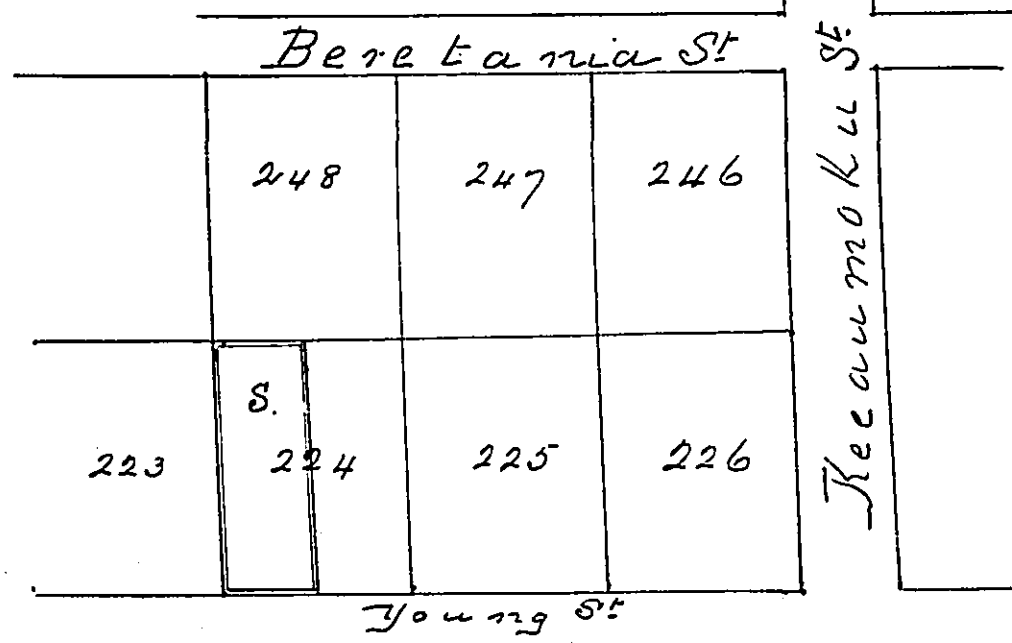
Kihae Kihae Honolulu in the Island of Oahu and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on waihana side of Young Street 215<sup>to</sup> feet from north angle of Young & Kahanu Streets, thence by two bearings:

- N. 21° 12' E 116.7
- S. 68° 48' W 50
- S. 25° 19' W 116.7
- S. 68° 48' E 50

That the said described premises shall be properly fenced and Water laid on from the Government system within one year from the date hereof.
