## GRANT.

**KALAKAUA**, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

*John J. Hackfeld*

for the consideration of Three Thousand & Sixty (\$3,060-) Dollars paid into the Royal Eschequer, all that piece of Land situate at South Slope of Puu-ka-Pa Hill Honolulu in the Island of Oahu and described as follows:

Beginning at center of Granite post at north angle of **Waihona** Lunatic and Hospital. *Street* bearing by true bearings:

S. 21°15' E. 300 "

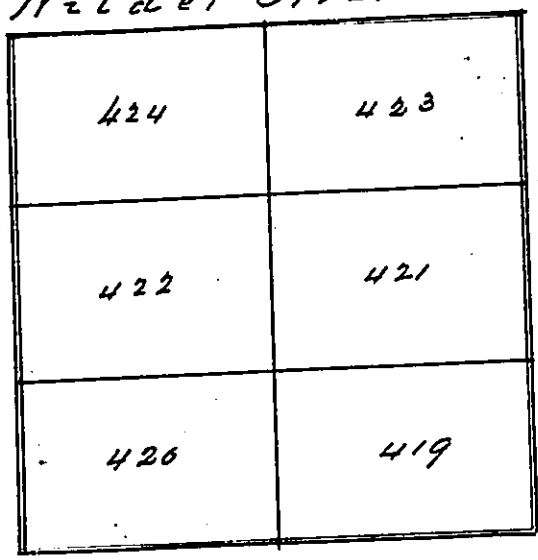
