# Royal Patent

## GRANT.

**KALAKAUA**, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

Victor J. Fugerees

for the consideration of One Hundred and Ninety four Dollars paid into the Royal Eschequer, all that piece of Land situate at

Kaluapalena - Kuliki in the Island of Oahu and described as follows:

Lot No. 17. Kaluapalena

Beginning at a point on mauka side of road 220 feet from N. angle of two roads as per Government Survey of Kaluapalena Lot, (April 1859) thence running by the bearings:

S. 48°00' W. 376.7 feet along Lot 16

N. 46°16' W. 110.3 " Kuliki boundary

N. 48°00' E. 385.6 " Lot 15

S. 42°00' E. 110. " New Road to the Initial point.
