By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

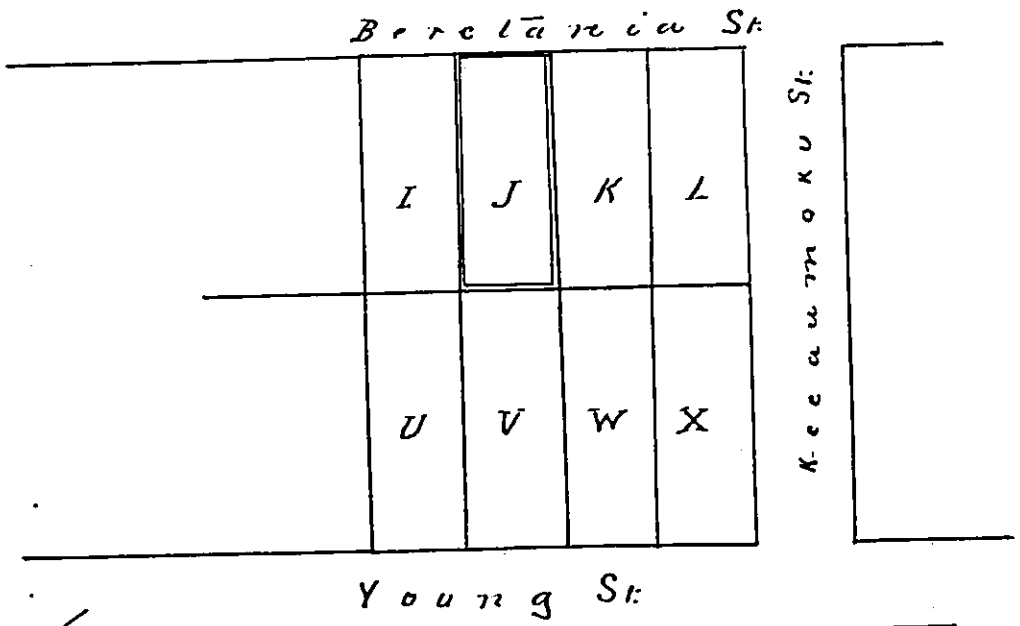
George Sialelei Tontoua

for the consideration of Two Hundred and Sixty-five (265) Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at Portaria Street Honolulu in the Island of Oahu and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of the new line of Portaria Street 100 feet from northward line of **Waihana** Street, thence running by the bearings:
N. 68 1/2° W. 50 feet along new line of Portaria Street

Initial point of 67 1/2' square feet.
