# Royal Patent

## GRANT.

**KALAKAUA**, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

L. Von Tempisky

for the consideration of One Dollar and a Certain Debt to the Hawaiian Government dated Dec 29 1880 and recorded in Liber on Pages paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at

Waiahoa - Pula in the Island of Mau and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on boundary of Waiahoa (Kualahou) this point being at beginning of course No 29 in R.P. 1453 thence the boundary runs by true bearings:

S. 32° 34' N. 715 ft crossing Waiahoa gulch and across spur where Waiahoa gulch intersects, Waiahoa gulch, to a pile of stones.

N. 79° 7' W. 819 ft along south side of Waiahoa gulch to pile of stones on edge of same

N. 18° 3' E. 160 ft a little more or less to middle of Waiahoa gulch.

From Initial point again.

S. 57° 9' N. 360 ft along land of Waiahoa

S. 54° 43' N. 206 ft along land of Waiahoa to a cross cut on edge of precipice of big gulch

S. 15° " " N. 175 ft more or less to middle of big gulch and thence makai along middle of gulch to end of 3<sup>rd</sup> course.
