GRANT.

**KALAKAUA**, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

H. M. Dow

for the consideration of Two Hundred and five (205) Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at South slope Punchbowl Hill Honolulu in the Island of Oahu and described as follows:

Lot 482.

Beginning at a point on North side of Magazine Street 213<sup>7</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from ~~middle~~ <sup>Waihoia</sup> line of Spencer Avenue, thence the boundary runs by ~~the~~ <sup>Waihoia</sup> ~~middle~~ <sup>Waihoia</sup> of Magazine St.
