GRANT.

KALAKAUA, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

F. Gomes

for the consideration of One Dollar and a certain Agreement to the Hawaiian Government dated 1st day of Feb. 2, 1891. and recorded in Liber on page part into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at
South Slope Punchbowl Hill - Honolulu - in the Island of
Oahu and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on mauka side of Spencer Ave at West Angle of Lot 519, thence the boundary runs by true bearings:

- N. 52° 30' W. 110 ft along ^{waipona} ~~side of ditch~~ side of Spencer Ave to point on mauka side of ditch.
- N. 62° 00' E 119.8 along ~~mauka side~~ mauka side of ditch
- S 87° 00' E 33.1 " to North angle of
- S 33° 00' E 34.8 " Lot 519.
