

ROYAL PATENT.

GRANT.

Liliuokalani, By the Grace of God, Queen of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this Her Royal Patent makes known to all men, that She hath for herself, her heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

J. M. Monserat

for the consideration of Fifty one $\frac{60}{100}$ ($51 \frac{60}{100}$) Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at

Oleloanoa — South Kona — in the Island of Hawaii — and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on makai side of Govt road, this point being on boundary of Oleloanoa 1st and 2nd, and N. 62° 15' W. line 150 feet from said Ahu on Oleloanoa boundary about 100 feet mauka of road, thence the boundary runs by true bearings:

- N. 62° 15' W. 656 feet along ~~Oleloanoa 1~~
- N. 59° 15' W. 176 " "
- N. 64° 45' W. 140 " "
- S. 5° 10' W. 180 " Homestead Lot 2.
- S. 9° 00' E. 280 " "
- S. 86° 10' E. 850 " on line with Ahu to pt. at makai side of road

N. 4° 45' W. 50 ft. along makai side of road to initial point.
