

# ROYAL PATENT.

## GRANT

*Liliuokalani*, By the Grace of God, Queen of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this Her Royal Patent makes known to all men, that She hath for herself, her heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

Helen Boyd.

for the consideration of Two Hundred and Fifty (250<sup>00</sup>) Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at

Waiakeakua — Maunoa — Honoa — in the Island of Oahu — and described as follows:

Beginning at a Sukui tree marked  $\equiv$  on south bank of Waiakeakua stream, 210 ft in direct line from junction of Waaloa and Waiakeakua streams, thence the boundary runs by true bearings:-

N. 14° 31' E. 352 ft across Waaloa and Waiakeakua Gr 206 (Rogers) 10 ft on middle of small ridge:-

N. 62° 45' E. 1600 ft along Gr 116 (Rogers) 10 ft on the ridge between Waaloa and Waiakeakua

Thence S. 25° 30' W. 1010 ft following crest of said ridge:-

S. 12° 15' W. 550 ft across the mouth of Waiakeakua valley to point on boundary ridge of Holovalu.

S. 65° 00' W. 570 ft along said ridge

N. 25° 25' W. 900 ft down slope and along Gr 51 (Kainalu) 10
