Piliakalani, By the Grace of God, Queen of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this ~~Her~~ ^{The} ~~Royal Patent~~ ^{Government of the Republic of Hawaii} makes known to all men, that ~~She~~ ^{It} hath for herself, her heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

L. H. Thurston Trustee for Robert Shipman Thurston

for the consideration of Four Hundred and Sixty (460) Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at South Slope Punchbowl Hill in the Island of Oahu and described as follows:

Lots 452 and 453.

Beginning at a point on the mauka side of Thurston Avenue 175 feet, east of the north east corner of Thurston Avenue and Magazine road and running:-

- N. 76° 15' E. line 200 feet Lot 452.
 - N. 13° 45' W. " 200 " Lot 451.
 - S. 76° 15' W. " 200 " Spencer Ave.
 - S. 13° 45' E. " 200 " to the initial point.
- Area 1000 Square Feet.
