Liliuokalani, By the Grace of God, Queen of the Hawaiian Islands:

To The Government of the Republic of Hawaii *It has*
By this *Her Royal Patent* makes known to all men, that *She hath*,
for herself, her heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

Robert Thomson

for the consideration of Two Hundred (\$200⁺) Dollars —
paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at

Ahuuloa — Hanalei — in the Island of
Hawaii — and described as follows:
